1. JOB DESCRIPTION

Sunday services:

- 2 Sunday Morning Services 8:00 am Liturgical and 9:30 am Traditional.
- First Warm Up: 7:00 am when brass or special ensembles are included, 7:30 am otherwise,
- Second Warm up 9:05 am, or 11:00 am services and similar.

Midweek rehearsals:

- Cantor and Orchestra rehearsals as needed, Wednesdays or other days, 6:00 7:00 pm
- Choir Rehearsal: Wednesdays 7:00 to 9:00 pm
- (Saturday rehearsals as needed (9:00 to 12:00 am).

Duties for this position:

- Play weddings and funerals for an extra stipend.
- Lead the congregational singing and praise of God in worship from the organ or piano as needed. This
 includes Sunday mornings and special services on Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and
 Christmas Eve.
- Participate, as needed, in such special events as an annual two-evening Christmas Pops with the Symphony, an occasional service at a church conference, participation in an occasional concert, or the like.
- Accompany organ or piano for the chosen choral literature and special music for the day at weekly rehearsals and worship services.
- Accompany volunteer, or occasional professional ensembles or soloists during rehearsals and worship services as needed. Accompany orchestra and bell choir during rehearsals and worship services as needed.

2. AUDITION/SKILL REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum of Bachelor's Degree in organ performance, and/or equivalent knowledge and experience in a leadership role in a similar church setting is preferred.
- Lead congregational singing in interesting and varied ways such as: verse end interludes or modulations; "lining out" the melody with a stronger registration; varied verse registrations; a varied harmonization on a verse; varied hymn introductions et al.
- Select and perform music (preludes, postludes, etc.) that is integral to the theme and flow appropriate to the day's hymns, and seasons of the church year.
- Accompany sections of the liturgy.
- Accompany brass or orchestral ensemble, or vocal or instrumental solo literature.

- Accompany, using organ or piano, the chosen choral literature and special music for the day at weekly rehearsals and worship services.
- Attend planning meetings for Christmas and Easter.
- Attend staff meetings as deemed appropriate by the Senior Pastor or Music Director.
